Service on the Junior Fair Board is one year, with the opportunity to continue through reapplying.

Throughout the year, you will join with the other members to promote the activities and ideas of the Great Kern County Fair. During the fair, you will team up to sponsor various events, assisting in the livestock show arenas, plus assistance to the Senior Fair Board.

While many of the Junior Fair Board's past activities have focused on the livestock end of the fair, participation in various community events will showcase the community involvement of this fine group of young adults.
